

## Fall 2022 Student Fees for Teacher Education

### **GUniverse IPAD Fee \$600.00 (optional)**

Access to smart technology is a program requirement. If a student does not already have a smart device they use, they will be given the option to purchase an iPad through Graceland University. These options will be presented during EDUC2420. Entry Workshop. (Information about GUniverse can be found at [www.graceland.edu/GUniverse](http://www.graceland.edu/GUniverse)).

### **Educational Technology Fee \$110.00 One-time/Year one**

All Education students will be assessed \$110.00 when enrolling in the EDUC2420 Entry Workshop to cover the cost of their E-Portfolio account.

### **State Background Check Fee \$35.00 One-time/Year one**

All education students will be charged a onetime non-refundable fee of \$35 to cover the cost of state background checks required before they may go into schools for observations, practicums, and student teaching. This fee will be assessed and charged to student accounts for Lamoni Campus students when they enroll in EDUC1300 (or upon admittance for transfer students) and to Independence Campus students when admitted to the Education program.

### **PRAXIS Testing Fee (Varies depending on the Praxis test taken)**

All Education Students are working towards an Iowa Teaching License. To be eligible for an Iowa teaching license, education students are required to pass both a Principles of Learning and Teaching (PLT) test, as well as a Content Knowledge test for the major. Teacher candidates who complete the requirements for and receive certification from Iowa will also be eligible for certification in the state of Missouri without retaking the test or meeting the minimum score established by Missouri. The testing fee varies by test and is paid directly to the testing service. ### **Licensure Fees \$160.00 (paid online when applying for background check and licensure)**

To receive licensure, students are required to be fingerprinted by a trained officer or an official from the Board of Educational Examiners. The fingerprints are collected by the Graceland Education Office and are mailed to the **Iowa Board of Educational Examiners** (BOEE). The fee pays the \$75.00 background check and the \$85.00 fee for a teaching license. Fingerprinting is arranged during LEP class prior to student teaching. If applying to teach in another state, the fingerprinting process will be required for that state also.

Note: The fingerprinting and background check during Capstone is only for the State of Iowa. When applying for a Missouri license, you will also need to have fingerprinting and background check done for Missouri. More details, including additional fees, are available on the [DESE website](#).

### **Student Teaching Fees \$150.00**

Costs of student teaching involve the time, effort, and expense of making the placement as well as that of reimbursing the cooperating teacher. All students are required to pay this "Student Teaching" fee (\$140 for cooperating teacher; \$10 administrative expenses). The fee is automatically charged to the student account when a candidate is registered for Student Teaching. Additional costs will be incurred for special placements outside the 40-mile radius of the student's home campus.

### **Student Teaching Abroad / Distance Placements**
