Graceland University On-campus Living Policy

Graceland University's Lamoni Campus is a residential campus. We believe living on campus is an essential part of the GU educational experience. All full-time students (enrolled in 12 credit hours or more) are required to live in university housing. Due to the limited availability of on campus housing, some students will be approved to live off campus. Students must have senior status (88 hours or more) to be eligible to apply live off campus, or meet one of the following four exemptions.

Automatic exemptions to the policy are granted for students who (please check all that apply to you):

- are 23 years of age or older
- are military veterans*
- have legal dependent(s) who live(s) with them*
- are legally married*

* Please include copy of documentation such as: a marriage license, birth certificate, or military ID with application.

Currently enrolled students who want to live off campus (who do not meet the above exemptions) must submit an Off Campus Application to the Residence Life Office by March 19. Applying to live off campus does not guarantee approval. Students who have been approved to live off campus will be notified within 7 business days of the deadline.

- I will be registered full-time for Fall 2021 classes by March 19. (Full time is 12 s.h. or more. This is mandatory for returning Graceland students.)

Thinking About Moving Off Campus?

Not so fast! Before you decide what's best for you, consider this:

Helpful Hints:

- Lamoni Municipal Utilities can provide you with a 12 month history of utilities. This can help you budget accurately.
- Don't forget food! Many students greatly underestimate their food costs when they move off campus. The average college student spends between \$5-\$9.50 per meal.
- Most Lamoni landlords require a twelve month lease even if you don't plan on residing in Lamoni for the summer. Make sure you factor in those months to your academic year budget.
- Pick responsible roommates. If your roommate leaves at semester or stops paying rent/utilities, you could be responsible for their share of the rent or finding a new roommate. Your landlord will not find you a new roommate.
